Transfer Rules within GCT for Riders Paying Fares

- Free transfers for 1.5 hours from start of a trip, for up to 3 transfers, where the current route is different from the last route, and between like services (express to express, local to local).
- Upcharges apply when transferring to a higher fared service.

Upcharges for Service Upgrade

Regular Local to Zone 1 Express	One-Way Cash	\$1
Regular Local to Zone 2 Express	One-Way Cash	\$2
Half Fare Local to Zone 1 Express	One-Way Cash	\$2
Half Fare Local to Zone 2 Express ³	One-Way Cash	\$3
ADA Paratransit to Zone 2 Express	One-Way Cash	\$0.50

Transfers to / from MARTA Free

Notes:

1. Eligible persons pay Half Fare when riding 1) local bus routes and 2) express route 412 trips between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
2. On local service routes only, children no taller than the height of the farebox ride free when accompanied by a fare paying customer.
3. Exception: \$1 Upcharge applies when transferring from Half Fare Local to Half Fare Express Route 412 trips between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
